Brian: You've all got to work it out for yourselves.

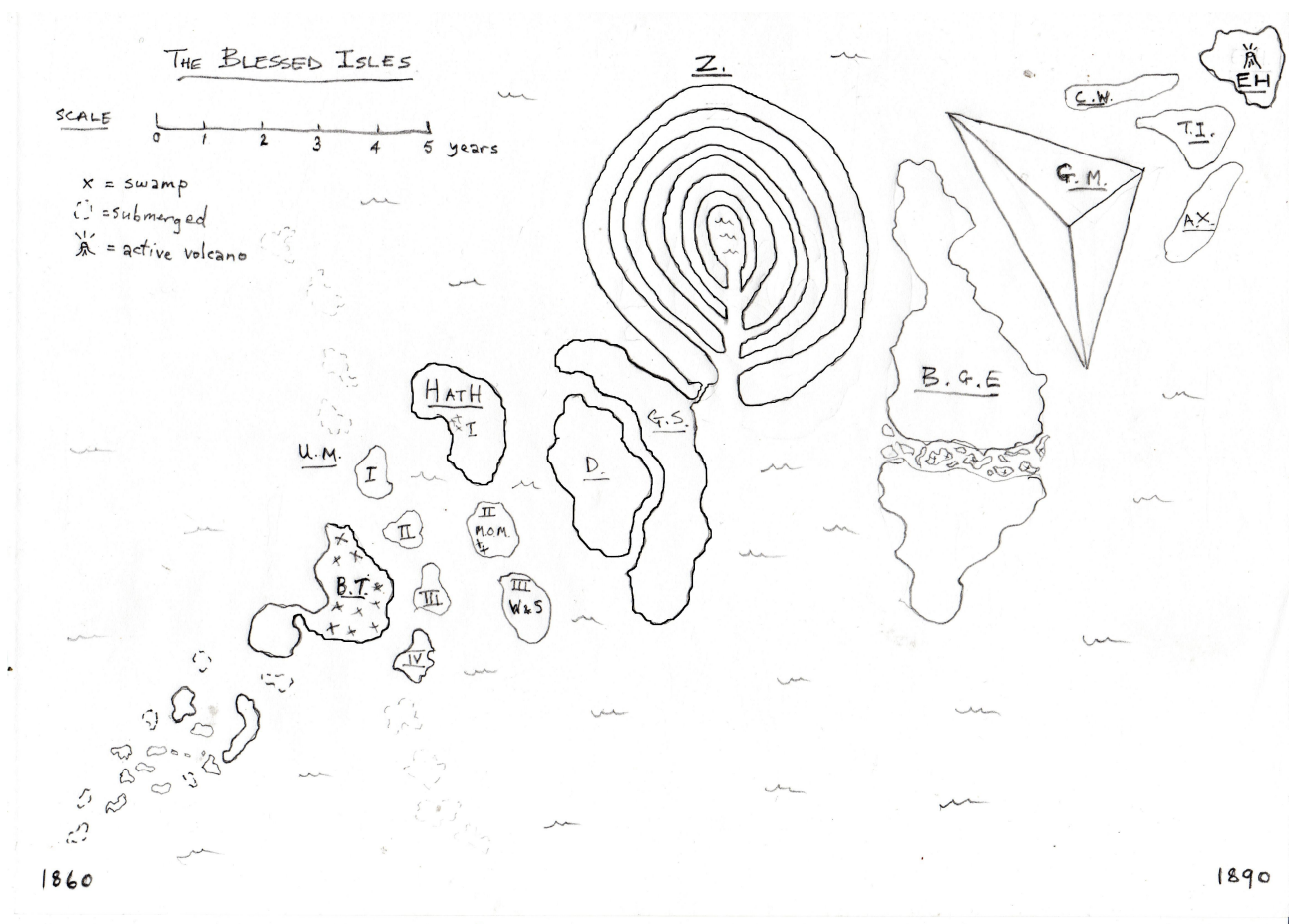
The Crowd: Yes, we've got to work it out for ourselves.
